- 27 km. of cross-country ski trails for both classic and skate styles
- Trails professionally groomed daily
- 10 km. of snowshoe trails. One snowshoe trail crosses Southern Ontario's longest 420' Suspension Bridge, offering a 10,000 square km. view of Georgian Bay and surrounding countryside.
- Situated at the highest point of the Niagara Escarpment, offering spectacular scenery and views. Trails wind through a 200 year old forest of 100 foot tall maple beech and oak trees, on 370 acres.
- Trails are well marked, and rated by levels of difficulty.
- Cross country ski lessons are available.
- Guided night snowshoe hikes may be reserved.
