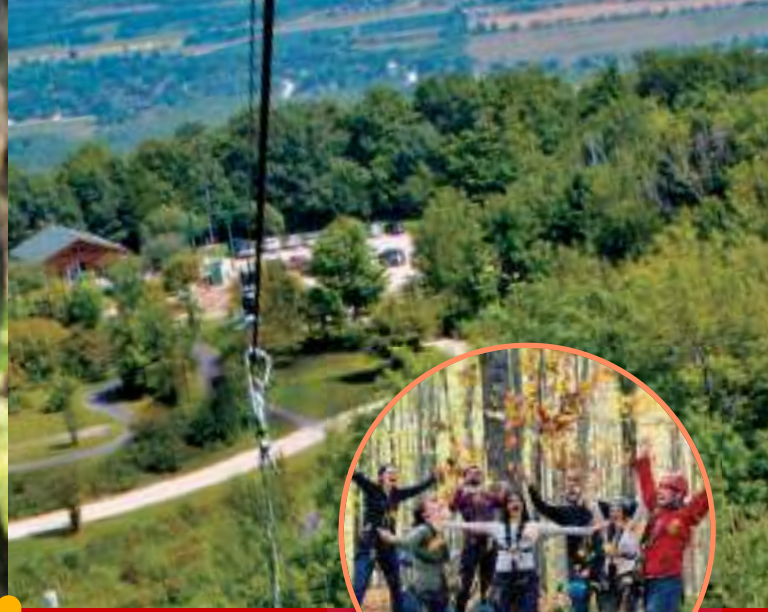

## Observe

At ground level, embrace a squirrel's-eye view of the biologically diverse ecology of the Niagara Escarpment. An internationally recognized landform, the Niagara Escarpment is the cornerstone of Ontario's Greenbelt.

Visualize how the 200 year old cathedral of 100-foot tall hardwood trees have become, and still are, a natural fortress.



## Be Brave

Clipping your safety lines to the overhead cables, you take your first tentative steps. Walk 20...40...50 feet up into the treetop canopy along a series of sixteen 10-inch wide airborne wooden walkways strung between a web of platform decks. Embrace and experience the geometry and order of nature in an entirely new way.

Like a fledgling bird, take your first flight, gliding from the last platform down a 330 ft. zipline, back down to the forest floor.

## Imagine

Your journey descends through a labyrinth of caves, crevasses and caverns long ago inhabited by Paleo-Indian hunters, the Huron-Petun First Nation peoples, Champlain and the Jesuits.

Walk the paths leading to the spiritual underworld, past the Standing Rock known as Ekarenniondi. The Guides share geological history and legends.
